Chief, Emergency Medical Services

I. INTENT:

To describe the conditions under which an EMT-P may render an ALS level of service in Sacramento County.

II. AUTHORITY:

- A. Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5, Ch. 4, Art. 1, §1797.220 & Ch. 5, §1798.
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9, Ch. 4, Art. 2, §100147.

III. POLICY:

- A. A California state licensed EMT-P who is employed, by a locally designated ALS provider at the time of an incident, as an EMT-P, EMT-I, field supervisor, firefighter, or in another capacity arrives on scene and ALS equipment is available, may provide:
 - 1. The Sacramento County EMS (SCEMS) EMT-P Scope of Practice (SOP, Program Document 2221), if locally accredited and the patient's assessment indicates ALS interventions.
- B. A California state licensed EMT-P who is employed, at the time of an incident, as an EMT-P, EMT-I, field supervisor, firefighter, or in another capacity arrives on scene and ALS equipment is not available may provide:
 - 1. The State of California EMT-I SOP.
- C. The EMT-P who is employed, at the time of an incident, as an EMT-P, EMT-I, field supervisor, firefighter, or in another capacity shall follow all applicable SCEMS policies and documentation requirements (including the generation of a Patient Care Record).
