**HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 1798.200 AFFIDAVIT**

**Title 22, Division 9, Chapter 6. The Medical Director may cause: probation of certificate holder, suspension, revocation, denial of certificate or denial of renewal of certificate; if it is determined that there exists an imminent threat to public health and safety.**

**§1798.200. The Medical Director of the local EMS agency may place on probation any certificate holder or suspend or revoke any certificate issued under this division upon the finding by that medical director of an imminent threat to the public health and safety as evidenced by any of the following actions:**

- (c) Repeated negligent acts.
- (d) Incompetence.
- (e) The commission of any fraudulent, dishonest, or corrupt act which is substantially related to the qualifications functions, and duties of prehospital personnel.
- (f) Conviction of any crime which is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of prehospital personnel.
- (g) Violating or attempting to violate directly or indirectly, or assisting or abetting in the violation of, or conspiring to violate, any provision of this division or the regulations promulgated by the authority pertaining to prehospital personnel.
- (h) Violating or attempting to violate any federal or state statute or regulation which regulates narcotics, dangerous drugs, or controlled substances.
- (i) Addiction to the excessive use of, or the misuse of, alcoholic beverages, dangerous drugs, or controlled substances.
- (j) Functioning outside the supervision of medical control in the field care system operating at the local level, except as authorized by any other license or certification.
- (k) Demonstration of irrational behavior or occurrence of physical disability to the extent that a reasonable and prudent person would have reasonable cause to believe that the ability to perform the duties normally expected may be impaired.

Fraud in the procurement of any certificate under this division may include, but not be limited to, not advising this agency of the following:

- (1) Have you ever applied for any prehospital certification in any county or state and been denied? If yes, explain and attach additional documentation.
- (2) Have you ever been the subject of a formal prehospital care certification disciplinary action or proceeding? If yes, explain and attach additional documentation.
- (3) Do you have any pending criminal actions, civil actions and/or EMS fact finding/certification review actions? If yes, explain and attach additional documentation.
- (4) Within the past ten (10) years, have you ever been made a ward of the court, placed on probation, fined (excluding minor traffic violations), convicted, placed on a criminal diversion program or given a suspended sentence in any court? If yes, list any and all occurrences, explain and attach additional documentation.
- (5) Have you ever been terminated by an employer for quality of care issues?
