PEI Statewide Programs

- **Suicide Prevention**
- **Stigma and Discrimination Reduction**
- **Student Mental Health Initiative**
- Training, Technical Assistance and Capacity Building
- Reducing Disparities through Racial, Ethnic and Cultural Specific Programs



PEI Statewide Programs – Single Statewide Entity

- Suicide Prevention
 - \$10 million annually/4 years
- Stigma and Discrimination Reduction
 - \$15 million annually/4 years
- Student Mental Health Initiative
 - \$15 million annually/4 years



PEI Statewide Programs: Sacramento Planning Estimates

- Suicide Prevention: \$332,950
- Stigma and Discrimination Reduction:
\$499,425
- Student Mental Health Initiative:
\$499,425

Annual Total: \$1,331,800



Assignment of Funds

- September 2008: Guidelines issued re: assignment of funds to DMH
- Sacramento received MHSA Steering Committee approval and Board of Supervisors approval
- DMH announced they did not have the authority to require counties to assign funds
- Sacramento withheld posting of Assignment of Funds

Assignment of Funds (cont'd)



- August 2009: OAC determined additional options were necessary
- September 2009: OAC adopted 8 principles to serve as the basis for the PEI Statewide Fund Guidelines
- Guidelines: DMH Information Notice 10-06
- Assignment of Funds: DMH Information Notice 10-05



Statewide Funding Guidelines – OAC Principles

1. MHSA Essential Elements
2. Collaboration
3. Conform with MHSOAC Approved State Strategic Plans
4. Preserve State-wideness
5. Stakeholder Input
6. Address all Three Project Areas
7. Evaluation



Statewide Funding Guidelines

- All funds will further the goals and strategies in the State Strategic Plans by conforming with recommended actions in those plans
- Programs will have a statewide impact and provide statewide foundation for counties to build upon for lasting results
- Funds shall focus on building system infrastructure, expanding community capacity, creating new knowledge and developing needed resources



Options for Assignment of Statewide Programs Funds

DMH Information Notice 10-05

1. Implement Statewide Programs through a Joint Powers Authority (JPA)
2. Implement Statewide and/or Replicable Programs through Multi-County Collaboration
3. Assignment to DMH to implement or to fund contract with JPA



Recommendation

- Assign Funds to JPA through Option 3
- Assign full Planning Estimate from 08/09 in the amount of \$1,331,800
- Assign full Planning Estimate from 09/10 in the amount of \$1,331,8000
