Admissions Criteria

- * ***Youth is 17-17 1/2 years of age getting ready to emancipate from the Child Welfare System***
- * ***Youth is motivated to participate in the program***
- * ***Youth must be accepted into CRH campus living program and agree to follow CRH campus rules***
- * ***Youth will live on CRH campus for a period of 3-9 months***
- * ***Youth must have appropriate behavior for a level 10 group home or lower level of care***
- * ***Youth must establish a bank account; checking and savings***
- * ***Male and female housing available***
- * ***Youth must be participating in an educational plan***
