## **Goals**

### **Children, youth, adults and older adults:**

Are safe

Are healthy and have access to health and mental health services

Utilize services that are oriented to capitalizing on strengths and achieving wellness

Live in the least restrictive level of care consistent with their preferences, needs and legal status

Engage in personally meaningful activities and participate in the community

Have personal relationships and are integrated in a social network preferred by the client

Have access to sufficient monetary support to maintain stability in the community

Abide by the law

## **Overarching System Principles**

Individuals are treated with respect, appreciated for differences and provided with the appropriate service response

All individuals seeking mental health services receive appropriate referrals

Individuals receive flexible and individualized service responsive to their cultural and linguistic needs

Individuals receive services that actively engage their social support network

Individuals participate as active collaborators at all levels of care

## **Outcomes/Indicators**

### **Evidence of:**

Stability including income, housing, and community integration for individuals

Functional outcomes that are validly measured

Development of individual's social network

Minimizing placement at the highest levels of care

Linkages that afford access to and coordination of services and support across providers and agencies

Services for co-occurring disorders

Fiscal efficiency in achieving outcomes and adequate resources to realize desired outcomes

Efforts to leverage other funding and to maximize revenue streams
