1. Dental – By September 2005 Restorative Dental Care services will be available to serve up to 100 homeless adults residing in specific transitional living environments.	a. Collaborate with other CBO's seeking dental care for the County's homeless adult population.	All
2. Chronic disease management – By September 2005, HCH will resume activity at shelter sites related to chronic disease management of diabetic patients and asthma patients which will include nutritional components	a. Conduct nutritional screenings for those individuals with chronic disease where nutrition makes an impact on disease process. b. Link to exiting programs like Sacramento County Clinic's POWER Clinic and Nutrition program. c. Identify current needs at each shelter r/t chronic diseases. d. 3. Respite Care – HCH advisory board will continue participation in over-site of respite care program.	a. HCH advisory board member will participate in over-site meetings and report back to HCH Advisory Board. b. Collaborate with other CBO and County agencies seeking respite care facilities c. Collaborate with local hospitals and discharge planning departments for discussion surrounding appropriate discharges into homeless community. d. Continue advocating for consumer respite services. (i.e. conduct satisfaction surveys.)	All
4. Communication – HCH Advisory Board will continue to maintain open communication with local area social service and health agencies to share information r/t the health care and social needs of the homeless; and conduct specific workshops to area health and community organization emphasizing the cultural needs of County's homeless population.	a. Gather information related to health care resources / needs by June 2005. Revised current HCH <i>Health Care Resource Booklet</i> . b. Analysis current survey to assist with development of the curriculum by Feb. 2005 c. Share current advisory board meeting agenda with local area programs to encourage recruitment of new board member attendance. d. Put meeting announcements and special activities and services in homeless newsletter. e. Collaborate with county specialty programs to conduct annual communicable disease and services summits geared towards the homeless population. f. Conduct SSI presentation with assist from local CBO's .	All
