

## **Senior and Adult Services SAS/SMUD Energy Assistance Team (SEAT)**

SAS/SMUD Energy Assistance program through SMUD offers several programs which can be of great value to low income seniors sixty five and over and dependent adults. .

### **Low-income assistance (EAPR)**

The Energy Assistance Program Rate (EAPR) offers eligible low-income customers a discount of more than 30 percent on their entire electric bill every month.

### **EAPR Qualifications**

The guideline below identifies income qualifications for the EAPR program.

<b>New EAPR income guidelines*</b> <b>Effective July 1, 2007</b>	
<b>Persons in household</b>	<b>Annual income</b>
1-2	\$29,300
3	\$34,400
4	\$41,500
5	\$48,600
6	\$55,700
Each additional member add	\$7,100

\*Households are eligible for the discounted rate if their income does not exceed 200 percent of the federal poverty level. These figures reflect that percentage.

### **Senior Citizen/Third Party Notification**

A program that provides for special notifications to prevent unnecessary service interruptions because of late payments.

### **Medical Equipment Discount Rate**

Customers in households where a full-time resident requires an electrically powered device for medical reasons may be eligible for the Medical Equipment Discount (MED) Rate.

### **Residential Weatherization Program**

Customers may also participate in the SMUD Residential Weatherization program. Qualified customers can, at no cost to them, have their homes weatherized to improve energy efficiency and keep down energy costs especially during the summer's extreme heat months.
