Social Work Interns

DHHS partners with CSU Sacramento to provide internships for Bachelors and Masters' level students who are currently enrolled in the CSUS Social Work Program. **Students must be referred by the Director of Field Placement.** For additional information, contact the **CSUS Field Office at 278-7189.**

Human Services Interns
